LFG Football Camp Goes SOUTH

Lauren's First and Goal Foundation proudly announced the first Lauren's First and Goal Football Camp South at the University of South Florida in Tampa on June 8, 2008. Sincere thanks go to Leo Govoni and The Center for Special Needs Trust Administration for their \$100,000 grant to LFG in support of its mission and the LFG Football Camp South.

LFG Football camps offer a unique experience for both high school athletes and college coaches. LFG Football Camp hosted by Lafayette College in Easton, PA, is the largest one day football camp in the nation. LFG South, in its debut, hosted by the University of South Florida in June 2008, fielded more than 300 high school athletes. Coaches from all divisions, more than sixty of them, enthusiastically volunteered their time and talent to support pediatric brain tumor awareness, research and cancer services, inspired by the courage and spirit of Lauren Loose. USF offensive coordinator, Greg Gregory explains, "I know the coaches enjoy being out here because it's a different experience for us. Most camps we work, it's all about recruiting. This one's for a cause and it's a lot different."

For a \$25 donation to LFG Foundation, campers have access to the expertise of many college coaches all at one site. Players have the ability to showcase their talent for these coaches. The value for both players and coaches alike is tremendous, but pales in comparison to the benefit for the 3,110 children who will be diagnosed with a primary brain tumor this year. The Foundation has allocated more than \$350,000 for research, nearly \$135,000 for pediatric cancer services and over \$31,000 for family support. The inaugural event was a great success. With the support and generosity of volunteers and campers, over \$10,000 was raised at this one day event.

One person can facilitate big change. Often times it is the smallest of people who inspire that change.



Half Million Dollar Milestone!

In the five years since the first Lauren’s First and Goal Football Camp, LFG Foundation has achieved a seemingly unattainable goal, raising more than \$515,000 for it’s mission. In 2008, the LFG camps successes put the foundation beyond the half million dollar mark toward it’s fight in finding a cure for pediatric brain tumors. In those five years, more than \$350,000 has been dedicated to research, more than \$134,000 to pediatric cancer services and \$31,000 to family support services. 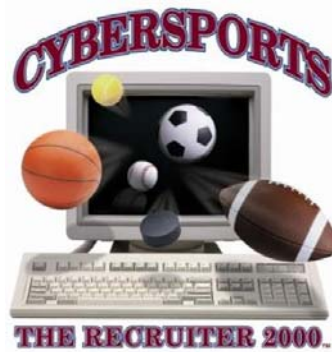
